Announcement relating to a decision to apply for delisting from Tokyo Stock Exchange (the "Exchange")

At the meeting of the Board of Management of Volkswagen Aktiengesellschaft (the "Company") held on 2 October 2007, it has been resolved that the Company will apply for delisting from the Exchange.

The principal reasons for the application for delisting are as follows:

- The low trade volume of the Company's share at the Exchange versus high and increasing administrative expenses accrued from listing at the Exchange,
- The similar factor as stated above has already led to delistings of the Company's share in several European stock exchanges over the past few years.
